**Regional Workshop on
“Gender and Inequality: A Practical Approach to Evidence-Based Policy Design”
November 7-9, 2023**

The International Monetary Fund (IMF)’s Middle East Regional Technical Assistance Center (METAC) and Strategy, Policy and Review Department are organizing a **regional workshop** in Amman, Jordan during **November 7-9, 2023**, on **“Gender and Inequality: A Practical Approach to Evidence-Based Policy Design”**. The workshop will be conducted in English with simultaneous interpretation into Arabic and French.

The workshop will focus on providing participants with a comprehensive understanding of the tools and techniques for i) identifying macro-critical gender gaps and assessing the macroeconomic impacts of gender inequality, and ii) assessing structural policy using a macro-inequality lens. Through interactive sessions, participants will learn how to effectively integrate gender into analytical and policy research and inclusive growth efforts. The workshop will also provide a hands-on overview of the basic concepts of inequality and macroeconomics using heterogeneous agent models and showcase country experiences from the MENA region.
