### Regional TADAT Good Practices Workshop for Fragile and Conflict-Affected States (FCS)

Amman, Jordan

December 7–11, 2025



Senior tax administration officials from **Djibouti, Iraq, Lebanon, Libya, Sudan, Syria, and Yemen** gathered in Amman for a five-day workshop focused on strengthening the application of international good practices in tax administration. Using the updated **2025 TADAT Field Guide** as a foundation, participants explored practical ways to assess the performance and maturity of core tax functions within their administrations.

Through interactive discussions, hands-on exercises, and peer exchanges, participants compared their current practices against the good practices outlined in **TADAT's nine Performance Outcome Areas (POAs)**. This process enabled them to identify opportunities to strengthen their ongoing reform efforts. They emphasized the importance of learning from each other's experiences, especially in light of the unique challenges faced by administrations operating in fragile and conflict-affected environments.

Participants expressed strong interest in continued engagement with the TADAT framework, including future assessments and follow-up support to guide the development of prioritized reform roadmaps.
