**Regional Workshop
Strengthening Tax Policy in the MENA Region
December 2 - 3, 2024
Cairo, Egypt**

The International Monetary Fund (IMF)'s Middle East Regional Technical Assistance Center (METAC) and the IMF Fiscal Affairs Department are organizing jointly a regional workshop on "**Strengthening Tax Policy in the MENA Region**" in Cairo, Egypt during December 2 - 3, 2024, taking place together with METAC's 20th Anniversary Conference on December 4, 2024.

The workshop will help member countries explore tax policy reform options to mobilize revenue, revisit the role of taxation in income distribution, and establish the institutional and analytical framework to enhance transparency and tax policymaking. Sessions will cover personal and corporate income taxation, tax incentives, establishing and strengthening tax policy units, and other issues. Discussions will consider common challenges in the region and good practices for reforms.
