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**Regional Workshop on “Supervisory Review Process and Pillar 2 Implementation”
October 26 – 30, 2026
Cairo, Egypt**

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) Middle East Regional Technical Assistance Center (METAC) is organizing a regional roundtable on “**Supervisory Review Process and Pillar 2 Implementation**” in **Cairo, Egypt**, during **October 26-30, 2026**. The roundtable will be delivered by Ms. Nehmat Hantas, METAC Financial Supervision and Regulation Advisor, and Ms. Magda Rejentova, expert in financial supervision and regulation. It will be conducted in English, with simultaneous interpretation into Arabic and French.

The five-day regional roundtable will bring together representatives from METAC member countries and the Gulf region to exchange experiences on the design and implementation of the Supervisory Review Process (SRP) and Basel III Pillar 2. The event is intended for jurisdictions that have already implemented, are currently implementing, or are preparing to implement the SRP. Through country presentations and moderated roundtable discussions, participants will share implementation approaches, challenges, and lessons learned, while enhancing their understanding of the end-to-end SRP cycle, governance arrangements, risk assessment and rating methodologies, business model analysis, internal governance and controls, assessment of capital, liquidity and funding risks, ICAAP review, and stress testing. The roundtable will also examine how SRP outcomes can be translated into Pillar 2 capital add-ons and other supervisory measures, and how these outcomes can be integrated into risk-based supervisory programs, supervisory intensity, early intervention, and remediation frameworks.
